To be eligible to add a Minor in Business Studies you must:

- Have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 or above
- Have achieved an average grade of 2.70 (B-) or better in MATH 208 and MATH 209. (Students who have received an exemption for MATH 208 must achieve a minimum grade of 2.70 in MATH 209, and vice versa.)
- Have completed all five of the John Molson prerequisites and have all grades posted on your student record. The prerequisites are:
 BTM 200 (Fundamentals of Information Technology)
 ECON 201 (Introduction to Microeconomics)
 ECON 203 (Introduction to Macroeconomics)
 MATH 208 (Linear Algebra)
 MATH 209 (Calculus I)
