

## Undergraduate Award Bulletin

### Loyola Foundation Inc. Entrance Scholarship 2018-2019

These scholarships were created through several endowment funds established by numerous donors wishing to support Loyola College. Their donations became part of the Loyola Foundation shortly after its creation in 1973 to be used for objectives, activities and purposes that would foster and maintain the tradition and spirit of Loyola College. At its closure in 2003, the Loyola Foundation Inc. created a permanent endowment at Concordia University which will fund the Loyola Foundation Inc. Entrance Scholarship program, honour the generosity of its donors, carry on the tradition and spirit of Loyola College, and recognise the academic excellence and good character of Loyola High School graduates in perpetuity.

**Annual Value:** \$2,000.00

**Eligibility:** This scholarship is available to graduates of Loyola High School in Montréal, who are newly admitted to a full-time undergraduate Bachelor's program at Concordia University for Fall 2018 on the basis of completion of CEGEP or equivalent. Students with previous University studies are not eligible.

Students who meet the eligibility requirements but were admitted to Concordia University for the Winter 2018 semester may apply to be considered for this scholarship for the Fall 2018 semester.

Applicants must be Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents.

**Selection:** Recipients will be selected by the University on the basis of academic achievement at CEGEP or equivalent and the strength of the recommendation by Loyola High School.

**Requirements:** The scholarship is payable during the Fall and Winter semesters each year, and full-time enrolment is required (minimum 12.00 credits Fall, and 12.00 credits Winter). The scholarship may be renewed on the basis of maintaining full-time enrolment and a Assessment Grade Point Average of 3.00 or better.

**Applications:** Application forms for this award may be obtained from the Undergraduate Awards Office in the Guy Metro Building, 1550 boul. de Maisonneuve West, room GM-230.00, or downloaded from the Financial Aid and Awards Office website.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: September 21, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.**

Applicants are required to provide proof of graduation from Loyola High School by enclosing a copy of their official Loyola High School transcript with their application. Applicants must also request a recommendation from Loyola High School on the Recommendation Form which is included with this application form. The recommendation may be enclosed in a sealed envelope and submitted with the application form, **or** it may be sent separately by the recommender directly to the Financial Aid and Awards Office.
