Candidates must pass a rigorous, four-part exam called the "Uniform CPA Examination" that is prepared and administered by the AICPA (American Institute of Certified Public Accountants).

Candidates must also meet educational, professional, and other specific requirements to the state or jurisdiction in which they intend to be licensed to practice. These requirements are determined by the appropriate State Board of Accountancy. If you do not meet those requirements, Morgan International has a solution for you.
