## CIBC Entrance Scholarships in Engineering

Starting in 2023-2024, CIBC has donated to provide funds for EDI student scholarships for the Gina Cody School of Engineering & Computer Science.

The CIBC Scholarships at Concordia will further the strategy to support a more diverse student body and future workforce within specific areas of engineering and computer science.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be in their first year of a full-time course of study leading to a bachelor's degree in computer science, computer engineering, or software engineering.
- The scholarships are open to Canadian citizens, permanent residents, and international students.
- Applicants must belong or identify with, one of the following groups: BIPOC, LGBTQ+, female, or disabled.

### Award Value: \$5,000.00

4 Awards for students in Software Engineering

4 Awards for students in Computer Engineering

For the categories above each of awards will fund one students from each of the following groups: BIPOC, LGBTQ+, Women and Student with Disabilities

### How to Apply:

Qualified candidates must submit, along with their application form:

- A brief statement (500 words) providing details as to belonging to, or identifying with, one of the following groups: BIPOC, LGBTQ+, female, or disabled.
- Indigenous students must also provide information on their nation and community of origin in their statement, as well as provide proof in the form of documentation to Financial Aid and Awards.
- LGBTQ+ students may also indicate why receiving this award would be meaningful to them.
