


Structure of the Major in Finance

The major in Finance requires the completion of 24 credits (8 courses). These include two required courses (6credits) and 18 additional 400-level elective credits offered by the Department.



Notes:

- 2. A prerequisite or co-requisite refers to a course that can be completed in the same term as the course linked by the double line (______). For example, FINA 385 and FINA 395 can be completed in the same term.
- 3. The Major in Finance consists of FINA 385, 395 and six additional Finance credits at the 400 level.
- 4. The two required courses appear bolded.
- 5. Students are responsible for following the correct sequence of courses required for the completion of a particular major. Students who fail a course must repeat it before taking the next course.
- 6. To review the course requirements for your year of entry in the program please refer to the undergraduate calendar or degree worksheet for that year.
- 7. **FINA 465** Prerequisite: FINA 409 or FINA 410; FINA 412. Students who have received credit for this topic under a FINA 455 number may not take this course for credit.
- 8. Three courses are not shown in the flowchart above: FINA 409 which requires permission from the Department, FINA 495 which is only available to students in the Honours in Finance program, and FINA 455 which is offered under specific topics and prerequisites relevant in each case are stated in the Undergraduate Class Schedule.
- 9. Fina 421Prerequisite: Fina 385, while Fina 395 must be completed previously or concurrently.
