

Change of Concentration process

The following are procedures for students who wish to **change their concentration to or add a:**

- **Minor, Major, or Specialization in Human Relations (HR)**
- **Major or Specialization in Recreation and Leisure Studies (RLS)**
- **Specialization in Therapeutic Recreation (TR)**

Requirements

Students must have completed a minimum of 24 credits at Concordia, with a CGPA of:

- 2.7 for Human Relations and Therapeutic Recreation
- 2.0 for Recreation and Leisure Studies

Students must submit:

1. A letter of intent (maximum 2 pages), which should cover the following areas:
 - Program you wish to enter
 - Reason for your choice
 - How does the program relate to your learning goals and your career goals?
 - List of previous and current work/volunteer experience that might qualify you for this program
 - If you think any element of your academic record is not reflective of your true potential, please explain
2. A completed and signed [Change of Concentration form](#).

Application Deadlines

- **March 1** – Fall semester
- **November 1** – Winter semester
- Applications are not processed for the summer semester
