

INTERNAL DEGREE TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS Psychology & Neuroscience

The internal degree transfer applies to Concordia students who are enrolled in a degree program and wish to transfer degrees to enter a program in Psychology or Neuroscience. Examples of this include students in the BSc wishing to switch to the BA in Psychology, or students in a BComm, BEd, BComp, BEng, or BFA program applying to transfer to the BSc in Neuroscience.

If you are a BA or BSc student who does <u>not</u> wish to transfer your degree but just add or change to the Major in Psychology or the Specialization in Neuroscience, consult our website section <u>Non-department Students: Entering a</u> <u>program in Psychology or Neuroscience</u>.

Eligibility Information

- To be eligible for the Internal Degree Transfer you must be a current Concordia student in a degree program.
- Internal degree transfers are considered for the Fall and the Winter terms only.
- The deadline to <u>apply for the internal degree transfer</u> is **March 1**st for Fall transfers and **November 1**st for the Winter.

Academic Requirements:

- 1. Complete a minimum of 12 credits at Concordia University.
- 2. Achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 3.00 (B).
- 3. Students wishing to transfer to the BSc in Psychology or Neuroscience MUST have completed and/or be exempted from at least 50% of the pre-science profile with at least one course from each discipline.
- 4. The completion of Introductory Psychology (PSYC 200) is suggested for people entering a Psychology program, if you do not have an exemption or transfer credits (TRC) for the course. PSYC 200 is not recommended for Neuroscience.
- 5. Admission to the Honours program is only possible after completing the first year of the Psychology/Neuroscience program.
- 6. Refer to section 31.250 of the <u>undergraduate calendar</u> to review the program requirements & course descriptions before applying.

Psychology & Neuroscience Courses Available to NON-PSYC Students:

PSYC 200/3 (year-long course) and other 200-level PSYC courses are open to all non-PSYC/NEUR students.

Students interested in taking 300-level PSYC or NEUR courses may attend a *course override appointment* in the first two weeks of each term to request permission to enroll, space permitting. The override dates will be posted on the <u>Department of Psychology & Neuroscience webpage</u> at the latest two weeks prior to the start of each term.

Transferrable Courses:

Credits completed at Concordia with a grade of C- or better and any transfer credits that you were awarded in your current program are eligible for transfer.
