The report recommends critical and tougher public health policy and regulatory measures.

This study investigates how COVID-19 lockdowns in Australia impacted gambling risk status by analyzing shifts in gambling behaviour and psychosocial stressors, exploring the link between restricted access, increase in stress and problem gambling behaviours over time.

Moodie, C., Morgan, A. J., & Alexandrou, G. (2024). <u>Perceptions of gambling marketing among young adults who gamble in Ireland.</u> International Gambling Studies, 1–19.

This study of young adults (18-34) in Ireland examined perceptions of gambling marketing through interviews with low-risk and high-risk gamblers. The findings highlight the significant impact of gambling marketing on young adults' perceptions and actions.
