



Job Description - Online Moderator

portraitX is an arts-based program that brings a custom app to public high schools to prevent teen dating violence. Our inclusive curriculum uses art and media to disrupt stereotypes and discriminatory attitudes that can lead to violence. With a trauma-informed lens, we teach adolescents the facts about sexuality and the essential skills necessary to navigate relationships online and off.

portraitX is looking for bilingual moderators to support our program's impact with adolescents 14-19 yrs old. This position is part-time. An initial 20 hours of training will be covered at 18\$/hour.

Our moderators will:

- Be part of a multidisciplinary team
- Be trained to implement tools and workshops via the portraitX app
- Deliver workshops to a group of 25-32 classroom participants

Our ideal candidate has experience engaging students in classrooms: encouraging conversation, ensuring that all students can contribute and communicate in a positive and collaborative way. Additional requirements include organizational and technology skills, prior work with youth in a community or educational setting and an interest in arts-based participatory projects.

Overall responsibilities include:

1. Complete portraitX training (including review of workshops, trauma-informed online facilitation, research protocol...)
2. Prepare and debrief for workshops + onboarding
3. Facilitate group discussions
 - a. promote social learning opportunities
 - b. engage with youth by posing open questions
 - c. thread together group discussions
 - d. move the discussion forward to develop and deepen students' learning and social learning skills
4. Keep a observation/reflective log
5. Collaborate with the portraitX online team (researcher, mental health resource, youth leaders) to ensure the learning, security and privacy of participating teens
