Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must have a GPA of 2.85 or higher.
- Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students are eligible.

Award Value: \$2,500.00

- A short statement to summarize how they have been involved (attended events or other participation) with the Concordia Armenian Students' Union (CASU).
