

## Undergraduate & Graduate Award Bulletin

### Brian T. Counihan Scholarship for Outstanding Contribution to Student Life

This scholarship was established in honour of Brian T. Counihan's contributions to student life over his 25 years as the first Dean of Students of Concordia University.

#### Purpose:

This scholarship is awarded based on scholastic achievement combined with outstanding contribution to student life.

#### Eligibility requirements:

- Undergraduate or Graduate level of study (Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral students only - not open to Independent Students, Visiting Students, or those in Graduate Diploma programs).
  - Candidates are required to have completed one full academic year or equivalent.
    - All candidates must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.30.
- Candidates must be enrolled full-time or part-time at Concordia University in Fall 2024 & Winter 2025.
  - Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and International Students are eligible.

#### Award Value: \$2,000

**Please note:** Students cannot directly apply for this award – **candidates must be nominated** by any Faculty or Staff member of the university community who is personally familiar with the student, their scholastic achievement, and their contribution to student life at Concordia University.
