Carlini-DeLuca Undergraduate RISE Award for Resilience In Science & Engineering Pathways to Success

The Carlini-DelUCA Undergraduate RISE Award -for Resilience In Science & Engineering Pathways to Success was established in recognition of remarkable undergraduate students in Science and Engineering, who are future focused and optimistic about their path to success despite navigating through personal strain and exceptional challenges.

Eligibility Requirements:

This Scholarship will be awarded annually to a student that fits within the following criteria:

- Full-time undergraduate student.
- Minimum GPA of 3.30
- Enrolled in either a Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Science degree
- Completed 50% of eligible credits / 3rd or 4th year student.
- Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students are eligible.

Award Value: Two awards each valued at \$1,500.00

How to Apply:

Candidates wishing to apply for this scholarship must submit, along with the application form:

- A one-page statement on why the award is meaningful to them. The statement will demonstrate resilience and perseverance while facing hardships during their studies which may have occurred from one or more of the following reasons: managing a health issue impacting their studies, lack of family support due to being an international student or a refugee, hardship experienced with loss of a family member, lack of mentoring or support, feeling marginalized and under-represented in society or in science/ engineering.

To submit your application, **all** documentation must be securely uploaded through your Student Centre.
