

Community Outreach Intern, Press Start Employment Initiative Fall & Winter 2024-5 Internship

Description of Organization

The <u>Press Start Youth Co-op</u>'s mission is to provide youth from Pointe-Saint-Charles and surrounding neighbourhoods a space to build community and to grow as individuals, a space where youth can develop a variety of useful skills and can work together to make changes in their communities.

Press Start Employment Initiative (PSEI) is the second phase of Press Start, both of which are responses to a community-facilitated consultation process in Pointe St.Charles. The consultation highlighted common themes experienced in the neighbourhood, such as the need for communal spaces, lack of employment opportunities, racial profiling, a desire for more environmentally friendly resources, and many other issues centering around a need for social change and youth led opportunities. Phase one sought to foster a communal space led by and for youth, phase two looks to address the lack of employment opportunities, specifically for marginalized youth aged 16-24.

Responsibilities and deliverables

This position would include integration into our 2-3 hour weekly coordinator meetings but otherwise involve a lot of self-guided work, such as:

- Help to connect us to other local organizations
- Expand our in-person outreach for engaging with local kids and teens
- Facilitating some of our free community programming, including upcycling workshops and supporting our engagement coordinator in other events
- Attend SHIFT's internship events and workshops as part of your internship hours



Assets and Requirements

- Student must be registered as a Concordia student
- Must be available to attend:
 - o SHIFT's Internship Kick-Off Event (4:30-7 PM, 5th September 2024)
 - o 2 virtual or hybrid workshops for professional development (dates TBD)
 - o SHIFT's Internship Closing Event (4:30-7 PM. 11th April 2025)
- Strong verbal and written skills, english and french language skills (more's great!)
- Ability to work independently
- Creative
- Has anti-oppressive values
- Interest in community work and youth work

Duration

24 weeks total; 12 weeks in the fall 2024 semester and 12 in the winter 2025 semester *Precise dates to be decided between the student and host organization. Possibility to renew over the Summer 2025 semester.

Site of employment

Most meetings, events, and workshops will be held at Batiment 7, 1900 Rue le Ber. We also work remotely during most of the week and are more on-site Thursday-Sunday. Occasionally, we co-work at SHIFT Centre.

*All SHIFT interns are also welcome to come co-work at SHIFT's space (LB-145) throughout the work week.

Hours: 240 hours total (roughly 10 hours a week)

Remuneration: \$5,000
