2. Current *curriculum vitae*.
3. Transcripts of current study demonstrating full-time status.
4. One letter of reference.
5. Examples of current work, as follows:
IMAGES: 8 to 10 images.
VIDEO: maximum viewing time 3 minutes. Include link to YouTube or Vimeo site (including relevant username and password and ensuring that links are tested using multiple search engines and devices)
Include a separate page identifying and describing the submitted images or video clips (eg. content, location, title, media, size or duration, year completed or indicate if work-in-progress etc.)
6. Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency (scan of Canadian passport, birth certificate, or Permanent Resident card).
