

# Extended Credit Program (ECP) and Mature Entry Program (MEP) for SOEN students.

Most students entering Concordia from a secondary school outside Quebec are admitted to the [ECP](#).

The [MEP](#) is reserved for Canadian citizens and permanent residents, 21 years of age and older.

Both ECP and MEP require the completion of 30 credits in addition to the regular 120 credit degree program (SOEN). The additional credits should be completed prior to following the regular program.

**Here is the recommended first-year schedule for an ECP/MEP student:**

## First Semester:

- CHEM 205 (General Chemistry I)
- MATH 203 (Differential and Integral Calculus I)
- PHYS 204 (Mechanics)
- Social Science or Humanities Elective (3-credit course)\*
- Natural Science Elective (3-credit course)\*\*
- English as a Second Language ([ESL 202](#)) (only if required – see Offer of Admission for deficiencies)

## Second Semester:

- MATH 204 (Vectors and Matrices)
- MATH 205 (Differential and Integral Calculus II) [requires C- or better in MATH 203]
- PHYS 205 (Electricity and Magnetism)
- Social Science or Humanities Elective (3-credit course)\*
- Natural Science Elective (3-credit course)\*\*
- English as Second Language ([ESL 204](#)) (only if required – see Offer of Admission for deficiencies)

\* **6 credits of Social Science and Humanities electives** must be chosen from the two corresponding lists found in [Section 71.110 of the Undergraduate Calendar](#).

\*\* **6 credits of Natural Science electives** must be chosen [from the list in the Undergraduate calendar](#).

**Note 1:** to be considered full-time, students must take at least 12 credits per term

**Note 2:** Regrettably, we are only authorized to assist in the registration of COMP, SOEN, ENGR and ENCS courses should seats be available, and requisites have been met according to the Registration Regulations.
