To be eligible to add a Minor in Business Studies, you must:

- 1. Have a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.50 or above
- Have achieved an average of 2.70 (B-) or better in MATH 208 and MATH 209 (students who have received an exemption for MATH 208 must achieve a minimum grade of 2.70 in MATH 209, and vice versa).
- 3. Have completed all four of the John Molson prerequisites and have all grades posted on your student record. The prerequisites are:
  - ECON 201 (Microeconomics), ECON 203 (Macroeconomics), MATH 208 (Linear Algebra) and MATH 209 (Cal I)
- 4. Starting fall 2024, CEGEP students admitted with exemptions in MATH 208 and MATH 209 will need to complete COMM 213 a grade of C- or better and COMM 214 with a grade of B- or better.
