






Structure of the Major in Management

The major in Management requires the completion of 24 credits (8 courses). These include two required courses (6 credits) and 18 additional 300- or 400-level elective credits offered by the Department.



Notes:

- 1. A prerequisite refers to a course that should be completed before the course that appears at the tip of the arrow (——). For example, MANA 362 must be completed before MANA 444.
- 2. A prerequisite or co-requisite refers to a course that can be completed in the same term as the course linked by the double line (______). For example, FINA 385 and FINA 395 can be completed in the same term.
- 3. The managment courses appear **bolded**. The two required courses appear in **bolded and underlined**. Prerequisites to MANA courses are shown next to the MANA courses.
- 4. To review the course requirements for your year of entry in the program please refer to the <u>undergraduate calendar</u> or <u>degree worksheet</u> for that year.
- 5. Students are responsible for following the correct sequence of courses required for the completion of a particular major. Students who fail a course must repeat it before taking the next course.
- 6. The Minor in Management consists of MANA 341, 420, and 6 additional 300- or 400-level Management credits.
- 7. The Minor in Entrepreneurship consists of 12 credits chosen from MANA 447, 451, 478, 480, 481, 482.
