
Model of the Information Search Process (Kuhlthau, 2004)

Asterisk

When placed near the end of a word finds variants. Can also be used for spelling variants.

Example: learn* = learning, learner, learners, learned





Quotation marks

Using quotation marks ensures that results retrieved contain only the exact phrase.

Example: "language policy", "educational standard*", "elementary student*"

Search strategy

"Inquiry-based learning" OR "Problem-based learning" OR "Project-based learning" OR "Experiential learning"









Scholarly vs. Peer-reviewed articles

- Peer-review (aka "Refereed")
 articles are a subset of scholarly articles








ERIC

Covers over 1,100 current journals, most of which are peer reviewed; also includes conference papers, research reports, and other grey literature (ERIC Documents).

PROQUEST COMBINED CANADA

Search for Education related stories in fulltext Canadian daily newspapers newspapers, news sites, and journal articles

<u>REPÈRE</u>

French language periodicals; useful for coverage of the Quebec education system.

<u>ÉRUDIT</u>

Scholarly coverage of education issues relative to Canada and Quebec

EUREKA

Provides full text access to English and French language Canadian newspapers, magazines, newswires, blogs and broadcast transcripts. A valuable source for regional and local Canadian news coverage.

CANADIAN PUBLIC POLICY COLLECTION

A large collection (over 43,000 documents) of electronic monographs and reports from Canadian public policy institutes, government agencies, advocacy groups, university research centres, thinktanks, and other public interest groups.
