Search operators - boolean

Other search operators

Exact phrase searching

Quotation marks ("") are used to search for an expression in its exact form (phrase searching). They are useful for expressions containing more than one word.

For example, "rite of passage" will find these words written together, without their variants, in that order.

Truncation

The asterisk (*), placed at the end of a word, replaces 0, 1 or more characters.

For example, chat* will find chat, chats, chatte, chaton, but also château, Chateaubriand, Châtelaine... It will not, however, find matou, félin, or lynx.

Another example: relig*: religion, religions, religions, religious, religious, religious, religious.

What is an annotated bibliography?

An annotated bibliography is a list of the sources (e.g. books, journal articles, etc.) that you used to research a topic in preparation for writing a term paper. In an annotated bibliography, each

source in the list is followed by a brief descriptive and evaluative paragraph of 4-5 sentences

(approx. 150 words or more), which can also include its relevance to your paper topic. An annotated bibliography should inform the reader by providing a clear indication of each source's

- Main Types of Annotated Bibliographies:

General guidelines

relevancy, accuracy and quality.

- Summary/descriptive provides a concise overview of the main arguments, evidence presented, and conclusions
- Critical/evaluative in addition to providing an overview, analyzes the content; comments on the strengths and weaknesses of the arguments, evidence, and conclusions; explains the usefulness of the source for your research topic.
- Combination most annotated bibliography assignments require that you include both an overview and evaluative comments.
- Most annotated bibliographies organize sources alphabetically by the first author's last name.
- Consistently follow the rules of the style guide (APA, MLA, Chicago, Other Guides) that is
 indicated in your course assignment instructions; the style guide will detail what information
 to include for each type of source and how it should be formatted.
