Internship description

To conduct a comprehensive survey of alumni who have remained in Quebec to live and work in French. The results of this survey aims to understand the demographics, career trajectories, and social integration of Concordia alumni. The aim is to measure the French learning impact on international students on their career path and their integration in the Quebec province. Specifically, we seek to: 1. Find out if international alumni have found a job and remained in Québec following graduation; 2. Determine if their level of French is sufficient for them to find a career relevant to their degree in the province of Québec; 3. Are the services regarding French-language acquisition sufficient at Concordia. The survey will be sent to international student alumni who have taken French courses at Concordia and outside.

- Design and develop a survey tailored to the target population.
- Administer the survey using various outreach strategies to maximize response rates.
- Analyze quantitative and qualitative data to identify trends and patterns.
- Prepare reports and presentations summarizing research findings.
